A YEAR IN REVIEW

Dear Friends,

This calendar illustrates the accomplishments you helped us achieve last year.

From starting new businesses, to stewarding our land and water, to transforming the food our children eat, your donations and your actions helped lift the future of the Center and the people we serve. Take a few examples.

Last fall we opened two new public art projects in small Northeast Nebraska towns. Each project drove deep community engagement and demonstrated that small towns can be interesting places.

Recently we learned of two capital gifts totaling \$750,000 that will jump-start our New American Loan Fund. We will create loan products to help new Americans build a credit history and become full participants in the economy.

In Washington, you helped stop cuts to conservation programs, and put the issue of crop insurance reform on the agenda. Closer to home, you won a fight between giant meatpackers and family farmers over who will own our livestock.

And, finally, we are attracting a new generation of supporters to carry on the traditions many of you helped build. These and more make up the accomplishments you helped us achieve.

As I travel near and far visiting with many of you, I am humbled and inspired. Center for Rural Affairs supporters are amazing. Many of you are deeply committed to the Center, and have been for decades. We are incredibly proud to have your support.

Since the Center for Rural Affairs began in 1973, a commitment to democracy, fairness, and opportunity has guided our work. We believe that by working together with you, we can create communities guided by these values.

YOUR 2015 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 36 aspiring and beginning Latino farmers added financial management, business planning, marketing, and production skills from attending specialized training sessions and farm tours.
- 5 Latino beginning farmers built exceptional relationships with local USDA staff. Each applied for farm loans, a first step in building credit and realizing a profitable future on the farm.
- Over 180 veteran-farmers created networks to help each other start farming and learn new enterprises. Organizations in Missouri responded by adding a farm training incubator at Fort Leonard Wood in the heart of the Ozarks.
- 214 people received individualized help with land access issues; 250,000 people visited the vast collection of beginning farmer resources at cfra.org.
- 60 people from the Santee Sioux and Omaha Tribes rekindled their interest in canning and preserving, cultural and historical aspects of growing food, and water conservation. Result: 30 new gardeners, 8 actively selling at the Santee farmers markets and 12 in the communities of Macy and Walhill.
- More than 70 million acres now protected under the Conservation Stewardship Program, a federal farm conservation program you helped win.
- More than \$50 million invested in small business development and low-interest loan capital in 42 states through the federal Rural Microentrepreneur Assistance Program. That's a policy you helped win.
- A new Farm to School Guide included a "Find-A-Farmer" tool, helpful to rural schools looking to connect to local farmers and ranchers in Nebraska.
- U.S. Representative Jeff Fortenberry visited the Norris Schools in Nebraska to promote the Child Nutrition Act Reauthorization and the introduction of the 2015 Farm to School Bill.
- Mark Winne, nationally known for his work with food systems and food policy councils, kicked off the nuts and bolts of developing a food policy council as part of an emerging Center project.
- At Huerto Air Vista (a community garden for a primarily Latino neighborhood), gardeners cultivated twice the space over the previous year, with 20 plots dedicated to growing family food.
- Local organizers in Byway of Art towns enthusiastically promoted their public arts projects. In Decatur and Lyons, the grand openings lit the imagination of excited audiences. Questions from nearby towns and from across the country poured in, asking about starting similar projects
- We crossed the \$12 million mark in total small business loans placed in history of the Center. That's money creating opportunity in small towns.
- We celebrated 25 years of serving small rural businesses with stellar technical assistance, training, networking, and loan capital. Our business specialists work with awesome entrepreneurs, as you'll see in May's "This Business Matters" photo array.
- Nebraska Public Power District decided to convert their coal-fired plant at Sheldon Station to a non-emitting fuel source, thanks to your voices.
- We'll turn to you again to push for a full transition to wind, solar, and energy efficiency as the Clean Power Plan makes itself felt.



VICTORY

Because of your support, we stopped a bill in the legislature to deny counties the right to determine their own zoning protections. With grassroots support, we turned back an effort to allow packers to own hogs in Nebraska. Together we advocated for Medicaid expansion. In Montana we helped win health care access for 70,000 working people.

The land may slumber (depending on where you are), but you are out and about creating positive change. Jon Bailey, pictured left, testifies about Medicaid expansion. We work to keep rural voices in issues like local control in zoning battles, level playing fields for production of livestock, and access to healthcare for all.

Because of our "Women Caring for the Land" workshops, women know a lot more about how to get conservation practices going on their land, and, more importantly, how to tell tenants what they want. As Phyllis McCain of Norfolk, Nebraska, said, "It gives me the courage to be a woman in a man's field and to stick up for myself and say, 'No. This is my farm. I'm the boss here.'"

Our Rural Enterprise Assistance Project ranked **#7** in the **nation** for Small Business Administration micro loans closed. We invested \$1,595,450 in loan capital in 114 businesses. An additional 1,838 people benefited from assistance with their business goals. We work one business at a time to build the rural economy with entrepreneurs willing to work hard to build their dreams.
