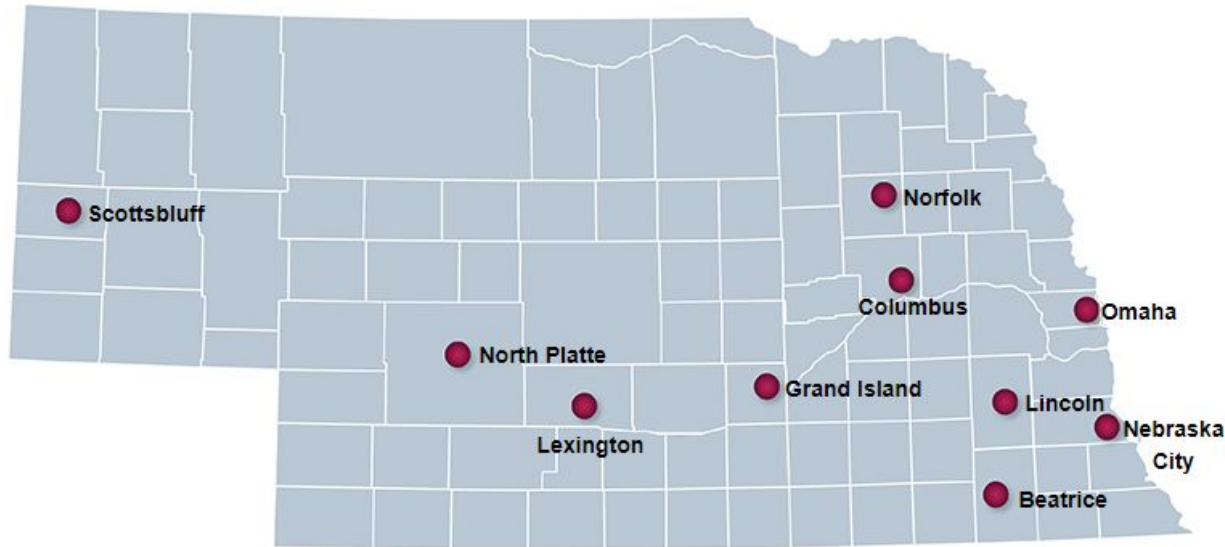

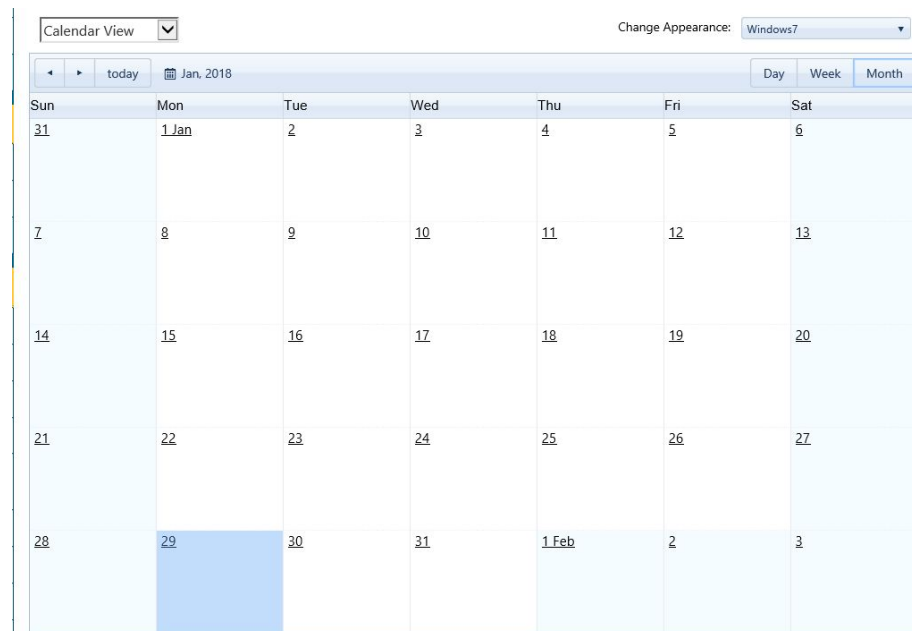

Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)

Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)

TAA is a federal Program to serve those whose job was lost due to foreign trade.

- Did your employer conduct business in other countries?
- Do they compete with products or services originating from other countries?
- Has your company been purchased by a company that does the same or similar work?
- Have you or a co-worker trained a replacement in another country?

Trade is a lifetime entitlement program. If you were part of a previous certification, you may have benefits still available to you.

You could be eligible for: classroom training, extended unemployment benefits, relocation, job search, and wage subsidy.

Unemployment Insurance

Unemployment Information

- Register on NEworks.nebraska.gov
- Post resume so it is active and online
- File unemployment claim
- Provide identity documentation as requested
- Begin work searching
- Be able and available for employment
- File weekly certifications
- Report earnings
- Respond to call-in notices
- Return to work = stop claiming
- Attend reemployment meeting if scheduled
